

Shawano County's 342nd Barn Quilt Erected

Shawano County's 342nd barn quilt is now on display at W1687 Shady Road, Seymour. The quilt, sponsored by Stacy Wesolowski, was a surprise gift for her husband, Kevin, for their wedding anniversary.

The pattern Stacy chose for the quilt is called Anastasia Patch, but will be referred to as the Wesolowski Patch. The color green is Kevin's favorite and matches the color on their shed. Purple was also used as it is Stacy's favorite. And pink, wrapped by a cross, represents breast cancer awareness, and is included since Stacy is a breast cancer survivor.

Kevin and Stacy's lives were patched together and stitched with love starting in 2015. Kevin has two sons, Kurt and Kyle. Kurt and his wife, Sandy, have a son, Kane, and a step son, Kolby.
