

Habecks Sponsor Ninth Barn Quilt

Roy and Phyllis Habeck have sponsored the ninth Shawano County barn quilt. It is located on their barn at W9932 One Mile Road in the Town of Herman. The quilt pattern they chose is called "Eight-pointed Star" and was selected because of its simplicity and striking color scheme.

The barn on which the quilt is mounted was built in the 1950s. The farm was purchased by the Habecks in 1974. The house and land are rented.
