

Shawano Rotary Club sponsors 14th barn quilt

The Shawano Rotary Club has sponsored Shawano County's 14th barn quilt. The quilt pattern is called "LeMoyne Star" and is displayed on the farm of Richard and JudyAnn Pahlow, W8224 Belle Plaine Avenue, Shawano.

"Our Rotary Club is all about community support," said Al Kuck, club president. "We think the barn quilt project will be great for Shawano tourism and shows we have pride in our community."

The Pahlows live on the farm that was homesteaded by Richard's great grandfather in 1865. Richard purchased the farm from his father, David, in 1970, the same year he and JudyAnn were married. The farm totals 247 acres.

The oldest building on the farm is an old smoke house that was originally used as living quarters. In later years, it was used as a laundry and as a place to make soap and maple syrup.
