

Bohm Dairy Farm sponsors 16th barn quilt

The family-owned Bohm Dairy Farm has sponsored Shawano County's 16th barn quilt. Gary and Christine Bohm with their son, Bryan and daughter, Katie, live on the farm at N4898 County Road F, Bonduel.

The pattern they chose is called "Blazing Star" and is a multi-colored design that really stands out on their 1930s red dairy barn.

Gary said the family decided to sponsor a barn quilt as a way to support their community and participate in a project that encourages people to take a drive to see Shawano County's beautiful countryside.

Gary's parents, Cennie and Lucille, moved to the present farm in April 1956 and Gary was born that August. Gary purchased the farm from them in 1983. They grow corn, alfalfa, wheat and soybeans, milk 75 Holstein cows and raise 75 steers and heifers.
