

Pella Eagles 4-Hers Sponsor Patriotic Barn Quilt

When Tim and Sue Schultz, Schultz Main Street Dairy, 1521 East Main Street, Embarrass, decided to sponsor a barn quilt as part of Shawano's countywide project, they asked members of the Pella Eagles 4-H club to give them some designs to pick from. After reviewing the patterns that were submitted, they chose one called All-American. It was designed by Morgan Weinig, daughter of Craig and Kay Weinig. But to the Schultz' surprise, the club decided to sponsor the quilt for them.

The original barn on which the quilt is mounted was built in 1937. Tim's parents bought the farm in 1957. He then bought it from his mother in 1992. The stall barn was remodeled and is now where the Schultz' 200+ Holstein cows are milked in a double-eight parallel milking parlor. The farm totals about 800 acres of cropland and the total dairy herd numbers about 400 head.

The Pella Eagles 4-H club is very active, with 48 members and more than 20 leaders. The two main leaders are Julie Bishop and Lynn Tober-Steinke.

The barn quilt is the 47th one to be put on display in Shawano County.
