

Szymanski Sponsors 67th Shawano County Barn Quilt

Ann Szymanski, who owns a farm at W1071 State Highway 160 near Pulaski in eastern Shawano County, has sponsored Shawano County's 67th barn quilt. Painted in bright orange and gold colors with a brown accent, the pattern, called "Circling Swallows" complements the brown trimmed white barn on which it is mounted.

The farm was homesteaded by the Szymanski family in 1931 and was purchased by Anna Mae and her husband Ronald (now deceased) in 1965 from Ron's uncle Joe who lived on the farm his entire life. The barn on which the quilt is mounted was built in 1991.

"I really appreciate the unique opportunity to participate in the barn quilt project," Ann said, "and am sponsoring the quilt in remembrance of my father-in-law Edward Szymanski who took great pride in the farm."
