

Knueppel Livestock Sponsors Its Third, County's 92nd Barn Quilt

Knueppel Livestock and Order Buying Inc., N5863 Oakcrest Drive, Cecil, has sponsored its third and Shawano County's 92nd barn quilt. The quilt pattern they selected is called "Colonial Garden."

Roger Knueppel formed the corporation in 1976. He purchased the first of three farms, known as the main farm, at N5863 Oakcrest Drive in 1978 from Peter Adasiewicz, who had purchased it from Jim Kohn, but only owned it a short time.

The farm had been used as a dairy farm but after Knueppel purchased it in 1978, it was converted into a steer feedlot. Knueppel Livestock raises Holstein and beef cattle on the three farms and the 500 total acres are used to produce feed for the operation.

The Knueppels were some of the first supporters of Shawano County's barn quilt project. Their other two quilts are just down the road from the third one, all on Oakcrest Drive just west of Cecil.
