

Shawano County's 124th Barn Quilt Called "Coming Home"

Jackie Suehring has sponsored Shawano County's 124th barn quilt as a surprise birthday present for her husband Mike. The quilt, called "Coming Home," now adorns the Suehring barn at W11055 Peaceful Valley Lane near Pella. "The quilt pattern is just what the Suehring household represents," Jackie said, "family and friends coming home to the family farm from many directions over the years. Mike and I are so happy to be able to support this Shawano County project. What a beautiful way to enhance our area's countryside."

A Grimm family originally owned the farm. Later it was owned by August Suehring, who sold it to Ed Suehring in 1934. Art and Irma Suehring purchased it from Ed in 1943. Mike and Jackie have owned the farm for the past ten years. The farm totals 180 acres, 100 of which are the Suehring men's hunting land.
