

Latest Barn Quilt Celebrates “Deer Camp”

Shawano County’s 105th barn quilt is located on a farm owned by Ken and Carol Capelle at W3174 Townline Road just east of Bonduel. The pattern selected for the barn quilt has been named “Deer Camp” and is of a whimsical deer that represents the deer the Capelle family, friends and neighbors hunt during Wisconsin’s annual gun deer season. The quilt was sponsored by Steve and Jolene Capelle and other members of the Capelle deer camp as a surprise to Steve’s dad, Ken.

“The farm is a favorite gathering place for family, friends and neighbors during the gun deer season,” Jolene said. “Everyone is always welcome to stop by and have something to eat, drink and share pictures and stories of the day’s hunting events.
