

## **Beyer Quilt is Number 162**

Shawano County's 162<sup>nd</sup> barn quilt has been sponsored by John and Nicole Beyer. Called Harvest Star, it is on the Beyer barn at N2454 Lawn Road, Pulaski.

John and Nicole purchased their five acre parcel from Ben and Sharon Fischer in 2011. The barn on which the quilt is mounted was built in 1901. Presently the Beyers raise some chickens, but plan to add hogs and cattle after they fix up the buildings.

John grew up in Green Bay while Nicole grew up on a farm near Suring. She was active in 4-H and hopes their daughters will participate in 4-H activities when they get older. Maison is two and a half and Harper is ten months old. Nicole is due next March with their third child.
