

County's 332nd Barn Quilt has a Sewing Theme

Shawano County's 332nd barn quilt is now on display on a barn owned by Mark and Angie Reimer at W306 Deer Drive, Pulaski. The pattern they selected is of a large spool of thread and is appropriately called Spool. "We picked that pattern because I've always done a lot of sewing," Angie said.

Mark and Angie have lived on the farm since purchasing it from Pete Wilinski in 2007. The barn on which the quilt is mounted was built in 1860 and was used as a dairy barn for most of its existence.

Asked why they decided to sponsor a barn quilt, Mark said, "We've seen them all over Shawano County and they look so nice that we wanted one too."

Angie added that she especially likes where it is mounted on their barn because she can see it so nicely from her kitchen window and every time they leave their house.

The Reimer quilt was painted by the Shawano County barn quilt committee and was put on display by LeRoy and Keith Raddant of Raddant Electric in Shawano.
