Shawano County's 361<sup>st</sup>, 362<sup>nd</sup> and 363<sup>rd</sup> barn quilts have been sponsored by Apple Creek Whitetails, 14109 County Road VV, Gillett, Wisconsin. Owned by Scott Follett and his family, Apple Creek Whitetails encompasses about 1,700 acres in Shawano and Oconto counties. It was started in 2008 when the Follatts moved to the area from Texas after purchasing the land and several herds of whitetails with 30 generations of breeding "big on big." Considered the number one trophy-guided Whitetail buck hunting in the United States, it has over 2,500 deer and also offers pheasant hunting and trout fishing.

The Follett family came from the food business and in 2020 launched the Primal Meats food branch which ships Wisconsin food all over the U.S. Keeping the ingredients natural is the key to the goodness of their smoked meats, smoked salmon, cheeses, raw honey, pure maple syrup, crackers and a line of consumables. The public is invited to visit the retail store to taste the products and see the massive whitetail mount displays.
